Contributions from Pima County, Raytheon Missile Systems, Rio Nuevo, and Rusty & Mary Garrett Take NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl Heroes Tribute Program Across the 7,000 Hero Line

TUCSON, Ariz., December 15, 2016 – More than 7,000 active duty military, veterans, police officers, sheriff's deputies, firefighters, paramedics, teachers, and underprivileged children will be provided with complimentary tickets to the NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl thanks to Pima County, Raytheon Missile Systems, Rio Nuevo, Rusty & Mary Garrett, and a host of local businesses that have contributed to the Bowl's Heroes Tribute Program.

Pima County's contribution will provide 1,000 game tickets for teachers and their guests, 750 individuals who currently serve in the military will be attending the game through Raytheon Missile Systems' contribution, and Rio Nuevo's sponsorship not only enabled the game itself but will benefit our servicemen and women. The Air Force Academy also donated more than 1,000 of their total ticket allotment to airmen at Davis-Monthan and Luke Air Force Bases.

"This will be the first time that many of our guest heroes will be attending a post-season college football game of this magnitude, and we're grateful for the level of giving that our business community continues to set."

Having now crossed the half-way mark to his Heroes Tribute Program goal of 10,000 tickets, Feder has issued a final appeal to local businesses to join with their peers in support of those who need it the most.

"Our goal is big and bold, but I'm confident that we'll have the privilege of sending 10,000 heroes to this game without asking for anything in return from them; it's really quite simple, they support us every day, and this is one day when we can come together to support them."
