Alan Young, Executive Director, NOVA® Home Loans Arizona Bowl states, "This year, we want Tucsonans to feel that the bowl in its third year belongs to them, they can be proud to know that Tucson is held in the highest esteem by bowl committees and teams around the league. The charitable giving from the 2016 Bowl game was nearly 200 thousand dollars with the largest donation going to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Tucson. A portion of the charitable donations will be presented at the press conference to Diamond's Children Medical Center and the Tucson Indian Center. Vantage West Credit Union President/CEO, Robert D. Ramirez will present the check to Jessica Galow, Senior Director of Development at Banner Health Foundation Tucson. The money will be used for the Diamond Children's Medical Center Hospital School Program. Banner Children's wants to ensure that hospitalized children don't get behind in school just because they are sick or have learning challenges. As a sponsor of the 2016 bowl, Vantage West Credit Union gets to designate the recipient of their charitable contribution.

The second donation will be made by Desert Diamond Casino Director of Public Relations & Community Events, Treena Parvillo. A contribution will be made to the Tucson Indian Center and will be accepted by the Tucson Indian Center Board Chairman, Rodney Palimo, Sr. The

Tucson Indian Center was first established as a Native American Club in 1957, the American Indian Association of Tucson, Inc., doing business as the Tucson Indian Center was officially incorporated in January 1963. The people who comprised this group were Tucson residents of the Tohono O'odham, Yaqui, Pima and other American Indian tribes as well as non-American Indian friends who wanted a place for Tucson area American Indians to gather for cultural celebrations, socializing, networking and community support. Over the years, the Tucson Indian Center has served American Indians and others who live in the Greater Metropolitan Tucson area and the non-reservation areas of Pima County, Arizona.

Through The NOVA[®] Home Loans Arizona Bowl Heroes Program, over \$200,000 in tickets were given to first responders, teachers, veterans and active military families. This program was funded by gifts and sponsorships.

The bowls' conservative estimates are that 14,860 football fans traveled to Tucson for the 2016 NOVA[®] Home Loans Arizona Bowl and their spending over 4 days translated into a twenty-onemillion-dollar economic impact. And, this does not include the indirect spending or "ripple effects" that always follows. The entertainment headliner at any bowl is an exciting component for any great game. During the press conference, the committee will announce who is performing during The Desert Diamond Casino Tailgate Festival from 11:00am0-2:45pm on December 29th, 2017.
